Weighing and measuring

Reception and Year 6 children will be having a visit from the school nurse next week to be weighed and measured. Chicken pox

We have recently had a few instances of children with Chickenpox. The Health Protection Agency guidelines recommend children should stay away from school for 5 days from the onset of the rash and we would ask that they do not return until the sores start 'scabbing over'.
