Enthusiasm for football is on the up here, and a total of twenty five players represented the school during the two games. Refereeing the games whilst managing the teams was always going to be difficult, however it was a real joy to be able to delegate responsibility back to our pupils, who did an amazing job of organizing themselves in terms of position and substitutions. Everybody played at least a half, and when players needed a breather they were all happy to be swapped, keeping energy levels high, which was reflected in two excellent results, the younger team winning 4-0 and the Yr 5&6 team running out 5-1 victors. The atmosphere before the game was one of sheer excitement and enthusiasm, which was reflected in an excellent turn out of parents, carers and former pupils; it was great to see so many of our old players supporting their younger siblings and looking so smart and grown up in their new uniforms. Considering we had so many pupils representing the school for the first time, it was a pleasure to see some of our more experienced players stepping up, encouraging and supporting their team mates throughout both games. It is always great to win in sport, but what was so rewarding for me was seeing everybody trooping off the field at the end, muddy, red faced and a bit sweaty(!) with great big grins on their faces! What a wonderful way to spend an autumn afternoon - I'm very proud of everyone involved!
