Head's Hello

Here at Lostwithiel, we are really trying to improve the attendance of the pupils in our school. The governors and senior leaders adopted a new attendance policy in July 2017. This can be found on our website and we will be sending out further information to parents this term. We understand that children are poorly sometimes and this is unavoidable. However holiday taken during term time and persistent lateness really does affect the attendance of pupils and in turn, will affect their learning. We really appreciate the commitment that both children and parents make in achieving good attendance at school and positive attendance will be celebrated in various ways throughout the academic year. We believe that attendance is linked directly to achievement and helps develop skills for life.

Here is an example of how regular non attendance can build up.

If a pupils attendance rate is 90% this is equivalent to absence one half day every week. In a year this equates to four whole weeks of lessons. A pupil that attends 90% of the time over five years will miss the equivalent of about one half year of school.

The Education Welfare service and Department for Education measure attendance in schools with the following measures:

99% – 100% Outstanding 96%-98% Good 94% – 95% Requires Improvement 90% – 93% Inadequate Below 90% Cause for concern

Our overall attendance target is 97% which is in line with that of a good school. We thank you in advance for your support.

Flu Vaccinations—Monday 9th October 2017

Children in Reception, Years 1, 2, 3 and 4 are scheduled to receive a nasal spray flu vaccination in school on Monday 9th October. Flu vaccines for children in Cornwall are taking place in school rather than GP Surgeries as this is deemed to be the most efficient way to ensure your child is protected and to deal with poor take-up. Consent Forms with information leaflets about the Vaccination programme were sent home with your child yesterday Thursday 21st September and Reception Class forms will be sent home today, Friday 22nd. All consent forms **must be returned to the school by Monday 25th September** (even if you child is not having the vaccination) as Kernow Health will be collecting the forms that day.

Health Checks for Reception and Year 6 children

Year 6 children will be weighed and measured and Reception children will have their vision checked as well as being weighed and measured. These forms will also be used for Reception children when they enter Year 1 to have their hearing checked.

Booklets with a detachable form have been issued this week to children in Reception and Year 6 for completion and return to the school office. If the forms are not returned consent will be assumed and your children will have the necessary checks.

YEAR 1 HEARING CHECK—FRIDAY 6th OCTOBER 2017

Children in Year 1 will be having hearing checks on Friday 6th October 201. Health check forms were issued to Year 1 children when they were in Reception class and these forms will be used to check for consent. If you did not return your form at that time consent will be assumed and your child will receive the hearing check.
