



Curriculum Overview – POP ART!

English

Handwriting

There will be a continued Focus on handwriting this term. Children should be forming their letters correctly by now. We are focusing on a consistent size, finger spaces and joins.

Read Write Inc

Continue to learn the phonemes required to make us good readers and spellers in RWI. Read various books and engage in discussion about these, allowing us to develop a deeper understanding of these texts. Focus on the spelling of exception words.

Writing

Children will be learning how to write descriptive texts. They will learn about compound nouns and adjectives as well as a range of punctuation such as question marks, full stops and commas.

Art & Design

Children will be making various pieces of art work including their version of Andy Warhol's Soup Cans. They will use a variety of different art techniques including print.



Mathematics

Multiplication

The focus for this unit is to be able to recognise and recall multiplication facts from the 2, 5 and 10 times table. We are aiming to know these off by heart. The children will also learn how to solve problems using these facts.

Division

Children will learn how to divide by 2, 5 and 10. This will link closely to the multiplication unit. The children will solve division problems and learn to recognise odd and even numbers.

Length

In this unit pupils will get a better understanding of how to measure length. They will begin by understanding what a metre is and what centimetres are and then progress to using them in real-life contexts.

Computing

As part of their Art and Design work, the children will be learning how to add an image into a document and how to manipulate the image in different ways to create their own Andy Warhol inspired art.

Geography

This will be a focus for a future topic.

Science

This will be a focus for a future topic.

PHSE

We will continue to focus on developing our Growth Mind-set. We will also be learning to 'Say No to Bullying' through a range of different activities. This will lead on from the Stay Safe workshop the children participated in last half term and supports Anti Bullying week which starts on 13th November.

History

The children will learn about the past, using common words and phrases relating to the passing of time. The children will find out about the lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to history.

Music

The children will continue with weekly Music Express lessons with Mrs Lawson as well as learning A variety of songs off by heart for the Christmas production.

PE

Children will take part in daily Leap Into Life sessions and children's yoga delivered by our Sports Apprentice.

Religious

Education

The children will continue to About Christian Stories including 'Jesus Healing the Sick' and the 'Nativity Story'. The children will learn why these stories are so important to Christians.
