It brings me great pleasure to share with you our exciting plans for our building and class structure for the next academic year. From September, we will be able to teach in single age classes, to keep classes small and maximise teacher time with each pupil. Our new, purpose built EYFS block will have two classrooms, Apple and Oak, that will have EYFS and Year 1 in respectively. There will be a free flow outdoor area both year groups can access and this will allow for a strong transition between foundation stage and year 1. Year 2 will be in the current 'Beech' classroom so that they can also access free flow to outside space. We have also dedicated some budget to improving the toilet facilities for the pupils. This, alongside funding donated from our very own LSA, will ensure toilet areas are light, bright and pleasant for our pupils.

Our SENDCO, Janet Bond, will be leaving us at the end of this academic year to work at other schools within the trust. Jo Barnes will be taking over as SENDCO alongside completing her SENDCO qualification. We are very pleased that she is taking on this role and will build on the pastoral work she already does in school. Teachers' and teaching assistants' classes will be confirmed after the May half term. Keep your eyes peeled for more exciting developments in Forest School and on the playground!
