

## A Parent / Carer Guide to Distance Learning at Lostwithiel

## How will teachers set work and how can we help?

- ✓ Teachers will set work on eSchools/Class dojo (or ILD in EYFS) using the below timetable (PE can be an active task each day)
- ✓ All work should be completed by the deadline given by the teacher-likely to be a week later.
- ✓ Teachers will acknowledge completion and then feedback if appropriate
- ✓ Encourage your child to work for about 1 1.5 hours a day
- ✓ Help them structure their day, have a place to work, and work without social media distractions
- ✓ Are they stuck? Use any books they have at home, own research, or call on friends to help
- ✓ Praise and celebrate their work, their resilience and their knowledge!

## How will teachers feedback work?

- ✓ Your child needs to upload the work as the teacher has asked
- ✓ Not all work will need to be uploaded and, just like in the classroom, not all work will be marked
- Marked work could be given back as whole class feedback where the teacher reflects on next steps suitable to all; or individually using the 'Feedback' function in eschools projects or a DOJO comment
