Please be aware that after school activity clubs have now finished for Summer Term.

Breakfast and After school provision will still continue with the exception of Friday 21st July, when there will be no after school provision as school will be closing at 1.30pm for the summer holidays.

Please be aware, from September 2023, there will be a slight increase in our after school club provision. The session will increase from £6.50 to £7.00 There will be no change for breakfast club.

We will also be sending an updated communication on wraparound care reflecting this change.

If you haven't already, please can you let the school office know if you need a regular booking for breakfast club or after school club for September.

This will also be to confirm if you already have an ongoing booking from this academic year.

Can we please remind you to ensure that you notify us of any changes, bookings or cancellations to breakfast club, after school club or child collection in good time. All changes to breakfast club need to be made by midday the day before and on midday on the day for after school club.

As we are coming to the end of the academic and financial year, please could parents and carers check their Parent Pay balances and ensure all debts are cleared by Friday 21st July.

Any credit balances on the account, will be transferred over to the next academic year.

During the summer term, please remember to send your child to school with a sun hat, water in a refillable bottle and ensure sun cream has been applied.

As the weather gets warmer, there is a need to be particularly vigilant at this time of year due to ticks. The area in which you live and where the school is situated is particularly prone to them.



Dear Parent/Carer

Here at Lostwithiel School we recognise that there are occasions when it is appropriate to authorise an absence, such as when a pupil is genuinely too ill to attend school, has a medical appointment that cannot be taken outside of school hours or a request for leave has been agreed in exceptional circumstances.

However, the Government does not support parents taking children out of school unless the school agrees this is appropriate under 'exceptional circumstances'. Any request for leave should be made in writing to the Headteacher using the school's request form.

If your child is absent from school without authorisation, you will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996. We may submit a request to Cornwall Council for a Penalty Notice to be issued, in accordance with Sections 444A and 444B of the said Act. Penalty Notices are issued per liable parent, per child and each carry a fine of £60 if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice may result in legal action. Absence not authorised by the school may result in a prosecution in the Magistrates' Court under Section 444(1) or Section 444(1A) of the Education Act 1996, leading to a fine of up to £2,500 and/or a custodial sentence. Cornwall Council may also apply for the costs incurred in taking the matter to Court.

'Parent' as set out in Section 576 of the Education Act 1996, defines parent to include: natural parents, whether they are married or not; any person or body who has parental responsibility for a child (as defined by the Children Act 1989) and; any person who, although not a natural parent, has care of a child. Having care of a child means a person with whom a child lives and who looks after a child, irrespective of what their relationship is with said child.

You are welcome to contact the school to discuss any concerns you may have regarding this or if you feel you would like advice or support in helping your child attend more regularly. Lostwithiel School is committed to maximising the education of all its pupils and aims to work with parents to ensure this can be achieved.

The decision to submit a request for the issue of a Penalty Notice will be considered when a child's attendance is deemed to be 'not regular'. The definition of 'not regular' in this instance is when it is below the threshold set by Cornwall Education Learning Trust (CELT). For all CELT schools, this attendance threshold is set at 96%, in line with national attendance data. In the Autumn Term, a child's attendance for the previous academic year will be considered before deciding on a course of action. From January onwards, the decision will be based on attendance data from the current academic year.
