Heads Hello,

We are delighted to confirm all of our children will be able to return to school on Monday the 8th of March. Each class will be returning on Monday – we will not be doing any staggering across the first week. The children will remain in bubbles for the remainder of the spring term with Apple and Cherry class being bubble 1, Oak and Beech bubble 2 and Maple and Conkers bubble 3. We have made some changes to the school day which are stepping towards 'normal' school life. These are detailed below. Teachers will wear masks when moving between bubbles, they are not required to wear masks whilst teaching their class. Children at primary schools are not required to wear masks whilst at school. We will continue with the risk procedures in place with extra cleaning and handwashing. Please contact us in school if you have any further queries or questions.

Drop Off

Bubble 1 (Apple and Cherry) will continue to be dropped off at 9 am the Apple class gate where Mrs Webber will greet you If you have a sibling in the other bubbles you will be able to drop them at the top gate first.

Bubble 2 and 3 will be dropped off at the top gate. Years 2 (Oak) and 3 (Beech) will muster and line up on the left hand playground and years 4, 5 and 6 (Maple and Conkers) will line up on the right hand side of the playground. Their teachers will be waiting on the playground. Ms Simmonds or another adults will be on gate duty from 8:45 until 9 am. You can drop off anytime between these times. This is to encourage natural staggering on the hill and at the gate. Children will come onto the playground and be able to play with their friends until the whistle is blown at 9 am for lining up. Please do not come before 8:45 as there will not be an adult on duty.

Pick Up

To stagger the pick up safely we will be continuing with the system we had prior to Christmas.

We are returning to a hot food menu. Children can still bring packed lunch if they wish to. We will send more information about this early next week.

Clubs

Football club will return for bubble 3 on a Monday from Monday 15th March, for those children who had been attending football club last term. We are going to start our full offer of afterschool activity clubs after the Easter Holidays. This will include running, netball and multi skills (for those children who have already returned their club slip). More information will follow.




This year the £1 Book Voucher is attached to this newsletter. You can download and print it or display it on your phone when purchasing a book at participating book shops.
