## Home learning ideas

- 2. Draw a picture of your favourite toys and write a sentence about it.
- 3. Talk about old toys together. How are they different?
- 4. Play a board game together, taking turns and following the rules.
- 5. Design a new toy or robot. Can you draw your new toy/robot or even make a model.

Please bring in any home learning to share I'm sure they will be keen to talk about their learning at home with their friends.

## Read, write inc.

Some children have moved onto the red ditty books for reading. There are 10 of these in total and each book has 3 'ditties' within it. A ditty a day is more than enough, sometimes you may even want to focus on the speed sounds or green words at home. Some children will have a laminated 'ditty' sheet to read. This will be the story they have been working on in their RWI lesson. In our RWI taught sessions we will continue to review the set I sounds. continuing our focus on the correct letter formation and good handwriting. You can help at home with this by practicing as much as possible.
